



CAMP EVERYTOWN

Retreat Staff Opportunity

Summary: An opportunity for college-age adults and community members who want to be involved in our schools, to share an empowering four-day retreat experience with local high school youth. Six to ten retreat staff persons are needed for every Everytown retreat.

Project Description: Everytown is a leadership training program where multicultural groups of high school students come together to create a community in which the barriers of race, religion, gender, culture, and ethnicity no longer act to separate. Student delegates are chosen based on their leadership potential; some are already on the track of traditional high achievement; others are acting out leadership in non-traditional ways. The goal is to empower all participants to be catalysts for breaking down racism, religious and ethnic discrimination, and intolerance in all its forms, thus helping to prevent and reduce incidents of community violence.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Promote the ideals of the Everytown community
- Act as a mentor and role model for the students
- Be a co-facilitator of small discussion groups
- Supervise youth activities and assure camp rules are followed
- Interact with student delegates as much as possible
- Provide evening supervision, bunking in dorms with the students

Qualifications:

Demonstrated maturity and initiative, exemplary character, enjoy high school age groups; willing to support and empower youth. All retreat staff hired must fill out an SV FACES application & be fingerprinted for purposes of a background check.
